



PREVENT FALSE ALARMS

USE THE FOLLOWING CHECK LIST TO MAKE SURE YOU'VE DONE EVERYTHING POSSIBLE TO PREVENT FALSE ALARMS.

1.) KNOW YOUR SYSTEM.

HUMAN ERROR IS THE SINGLE LARGEST CAUSE OF FALSE ALARMS. BE SURE YOU UNDERSTAND HOW YOUR SYSTEM WORKS.

2.) MAKE SURE ALL DOORS AND WINDOWS FASTEN SECURELY AND ARE CLOSED TIGHTLY.

AN UNFASTENED OR LOOSE DOOR OR WINDOW, PROTECTED BY AN ALARM SENSOR, CAN BLOW OPEN OR JIGGLE ENOUGH TO SET OFF AN ALARM. A BREEZE THROUGH AN OPEN WINDOW CAN MOVE PLANTS OR DRAPES AND TRIGGER A MOTION DETECTOR. AND OF COURSE, OPEN WINDOWS OR UNLOCKED DOORS ARE A SECURITY RISK.

3.) CHECK ON THE WHEREABOUTS OF YOUR PETS.

PETS SHOULD BE OUTSIDE OR CONFINED TO A PART OF THE HOUSE WHERE THEY CANNOT SET OFF A MOTION DETECTOR.

4.) LOOK FOR UNUSUAL ITEMS THAT CAN TRIGGER A MOTION DETECTOR.

EVEN SLIGHT MOVEMENT FROM A MYLAR BALLOON OR SIMILAR OBJECT CAN CAUSE A FALSE ALARM. REMOVE SUCH ITEMS FROM THE PROTECTED AREA.

5.) ANYONE WITH A KEY TO YOUR HOME OR BUSINESS MUST KNOW HOW TO OPERATE THE SECURITY ALARM SYSTEM.

ALL PERSONNEL SHOULD BE TRAINED IN PROPER ALARM OPERATING PROCEDURES, FALSE ALARM PREVENTION, AND HOW TO CANCEL A FALSE ALARM QUICKLY.

6.) INFORM ANY REPAIR OR SERVICE PERSONS WORKING NEAR ANY PART OF THE SECURITY SYSTEM OF IT'S PRESENCE.

TEST YOUR SYSTEM AFTER ANY REPAIR OR REMODELING WORK HAS BEEN DONE.

7.) TEST YOUR SYSTEM ON A REGULAR BASIS, TO ENSURE YOUR SYSTEM IS FUNCTIONING PROPERLY.

8.) NOTIFY FBN SYSTEMS @ 330-239-1229 IMMEDIATELY, IF YOU EXPERIENCE ANY PROBLEMS ARMING OR DISARMING YOUR SYSTEM.
